The solicitation named above is hereby modified as follows:

### **Question 1**

For clarification, on Attachment A, (Sample contract for service) 9, (a), (xiii), installation of remote control panel in doghouse - is Allied Crane supplying the remote control panel as a unit or just the controls? Section 9, (c), (i), states controls are OFM, but we are not clear about the mounting panel.

#### **Answer 1**

The Remote Control will be provided as a unit. The new device is a portable unit, not a "panel". The scope of work is to include removal of the existing remote control panel and installing a mount for the new remote control device. The subject is also referenced on page 20, 9, (g) (iii) "Disconnect and remove crane remote control panel and associated wiring from 01 deck doghouse. Crane start/stop switch (also located in doghouse) Is not to be disconnected from the motor starter nor removed from its present location."

### **Question 2**

For clarification regarding the waste of lead based paint:

- 1) Who will take possession of the waste, OSU or Contractor?
- 2) What paper work is required, if any, of proper disposal?

#### **Answer 2**

OSU will take possession for disposal of any lead based paint removed during the scope of the work. Contractor will be responsible to act in accordance with all applicable state and federal regulations for the removal of any lead based paint.
