

REVISIONS TO ACADEMIC YEAR FEE BOOK 2003-04

The following is a comprehensive list of corrections to *Academic Year Fee Book 2003-04*. Fee schedules posted at www.ous.edu/budget/fbk0304 have been updated to reflect these corrections.

OIT

Pg 38 & 81, (Fall & Winter/Spring), OIT Internal Distribution, undergraduates *nonresident* tuition for credit hours 1 – 8 should be the same as *resident* tuition for credit hours 1 – 8.

In addition, the Health Service fee of \$101 was omitted, in error, from the Total Charges (tuition + fees) for both resident and nonresident undergraduates, credit hours 9 – 11.

OSU

Cascades Campus regarding modification of tuition and fee rates for **Masters of Teaching** (*Cascades Campus only*), Fall, Winter & Spring terms. Upon official agreement, the following adjustments will be made to the full time published tuition and fee rates of \$2,983 (resident per term) and \$5,062 (non-resident per term): Fall Term 2003 tuition *refund* of \$600.00; Winter term 2004 tuition *reduction* of \$400.00; and Spring term 2004 tuition *reduction* of \$200.00.

PSU

Pg 97 & 98, (Winter/Spring), PSU has modified the tuition plateau as follows: *Resident Undergraduate* students taking 12-15 credit hours will pay \$1,080.00; *Non-Resident Undergraduate* students taking 12-15 credit hours will pay \$4,212.00; *Resident Graduate* students taking 9-12 credit hours will pay \$2,196.00; and *Non-Resident Graduate* students taking 9-12 credit hours will pay \$4,095.00 for tuition.

Students taking in excess of 15 undergraduate credits and 12 graduate credits will pay the per credit hour rate for each hour above these amounts as follows: *Resident Undergraduates* \$90.00; *Non-Resident Undergraduates* \$351.00; *Resident Graduates* \$244.00; and *Non-Resident Graduates* \$455.00.

SOU

Pg 10, (SOU) (continuation of) Other Tuition and Fee Policies, (5) ...Resource Fees Approved by the Board, Southern Oregon University: 'Speech and Hearing program – Graduate' should read 'Masters of Applied Psychology – Human Services Track'. This resource fee is new for academic year 2003-04.

UO

Pg 68 & 111 (Fall & Winter/Spring), UO Part-Time Non Matriculated Student Tuition, Combination Course Level for 6, 7 and 8 credits hours: tuition + fee totals are in error as they do not include the \$15 Registration Fee.

OUS Policy

The Concurrent Enrollment Fee Policy will be eliminated beginning Winter term, when tuition plateau changes will begin to take effect. The following sections regarding Concurrent

Enrollment in Two or More Institutions of the OUS, on Pages 24-25 of the 2003-04 Academic Year Fee Book, will be eliminated effective January 1, 2004:

- D. Concurrent Enrollment at Two or More Units of the Oregon University System
 - 1. Full-Time Student
 - 2. Graduate Assistants, Research Assistants, and Fellows
 - 3. Refunds to Students Enrolled in Two or More Institutions
