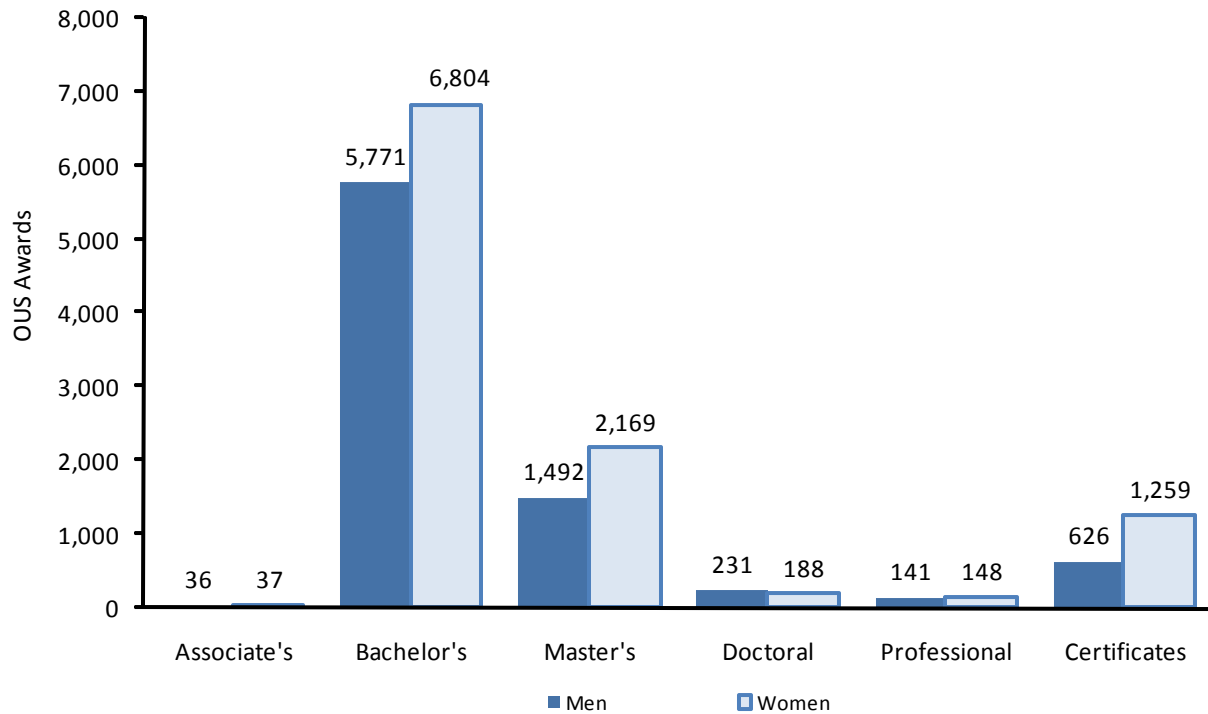

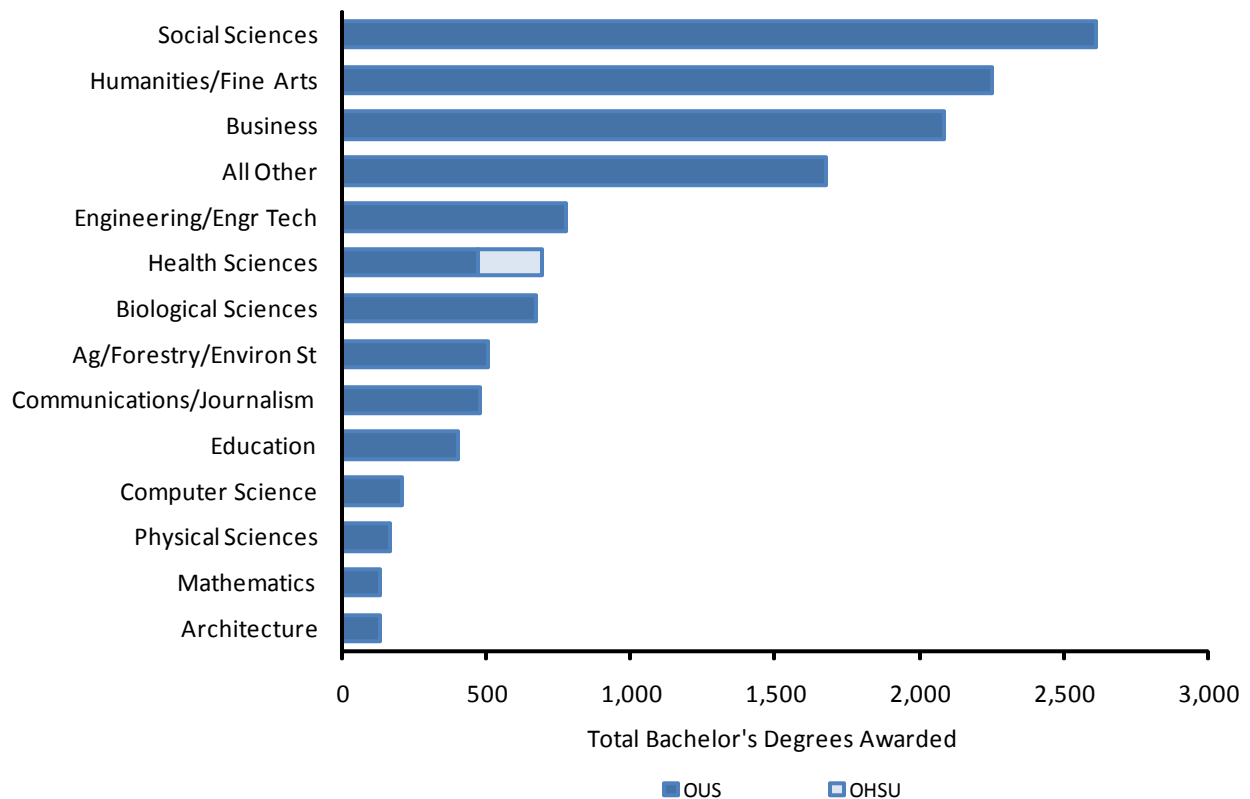

Bachelor's Degrees Awarded by Discipline, 2008-09



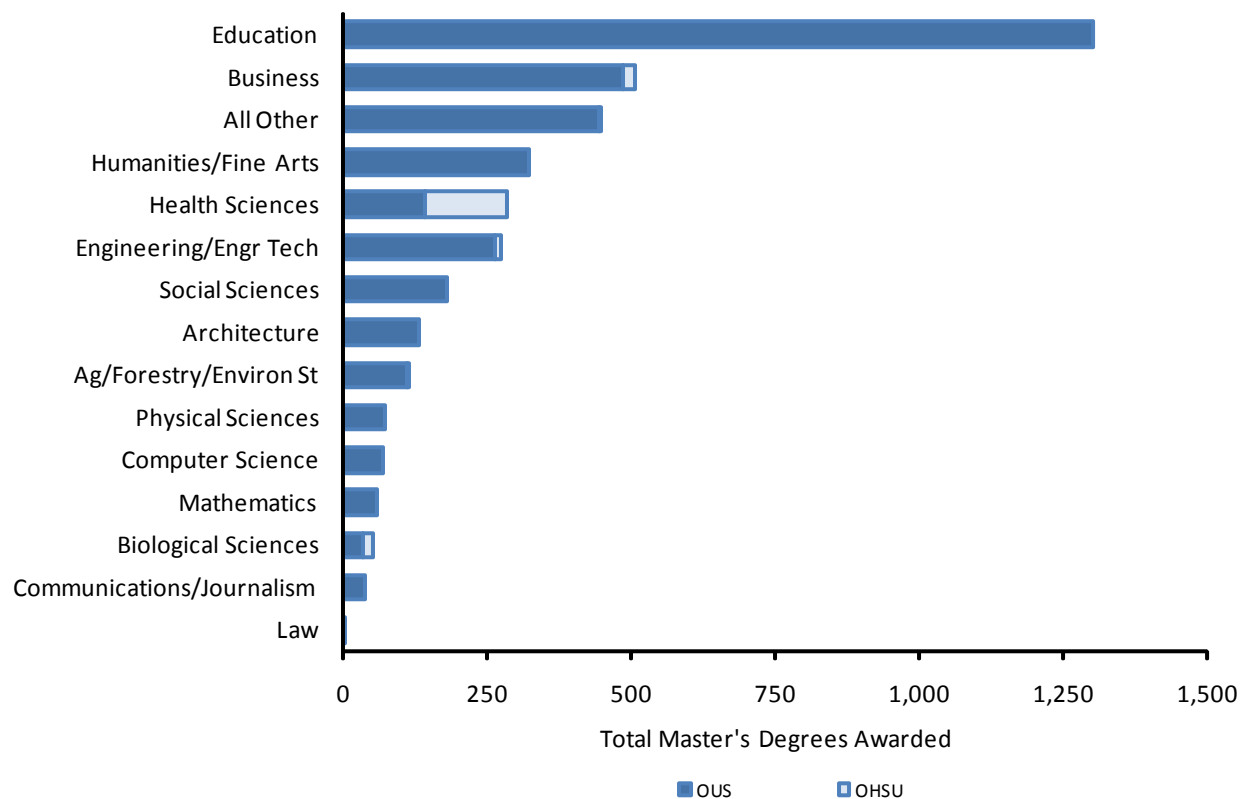

Master's Degrees Awarded by Discipline, 2008-09



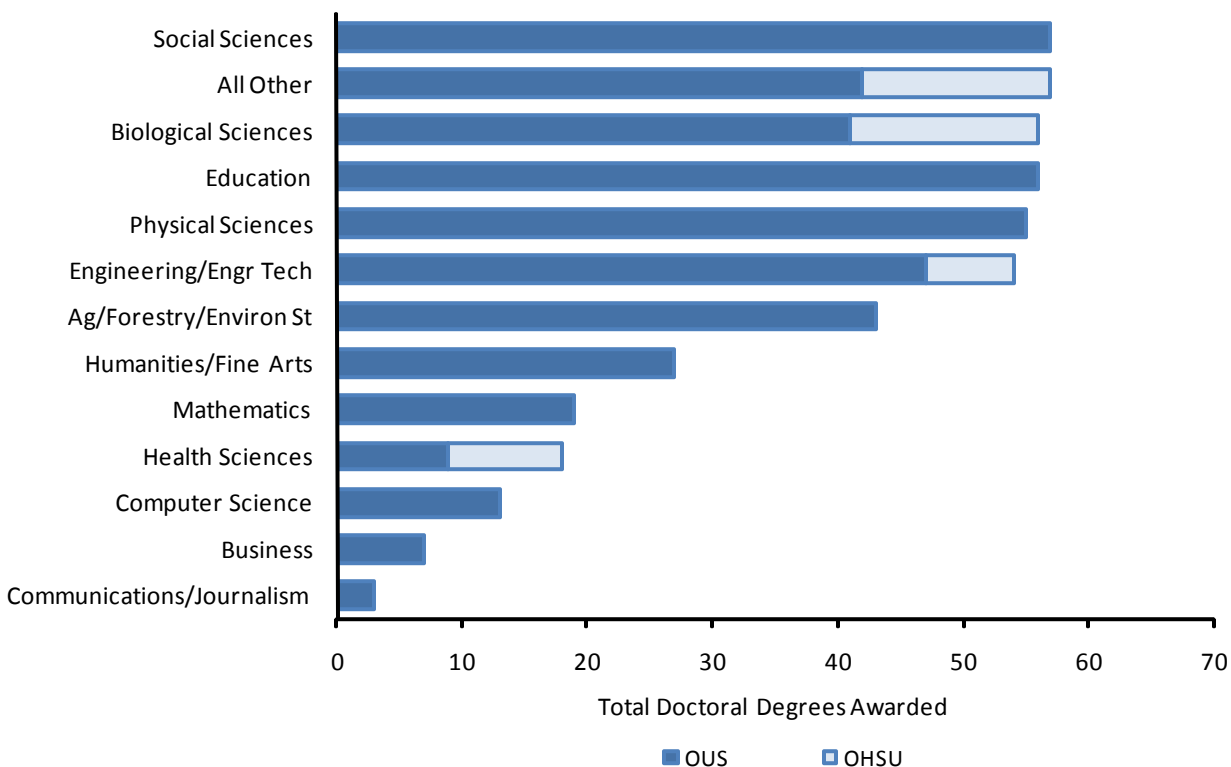

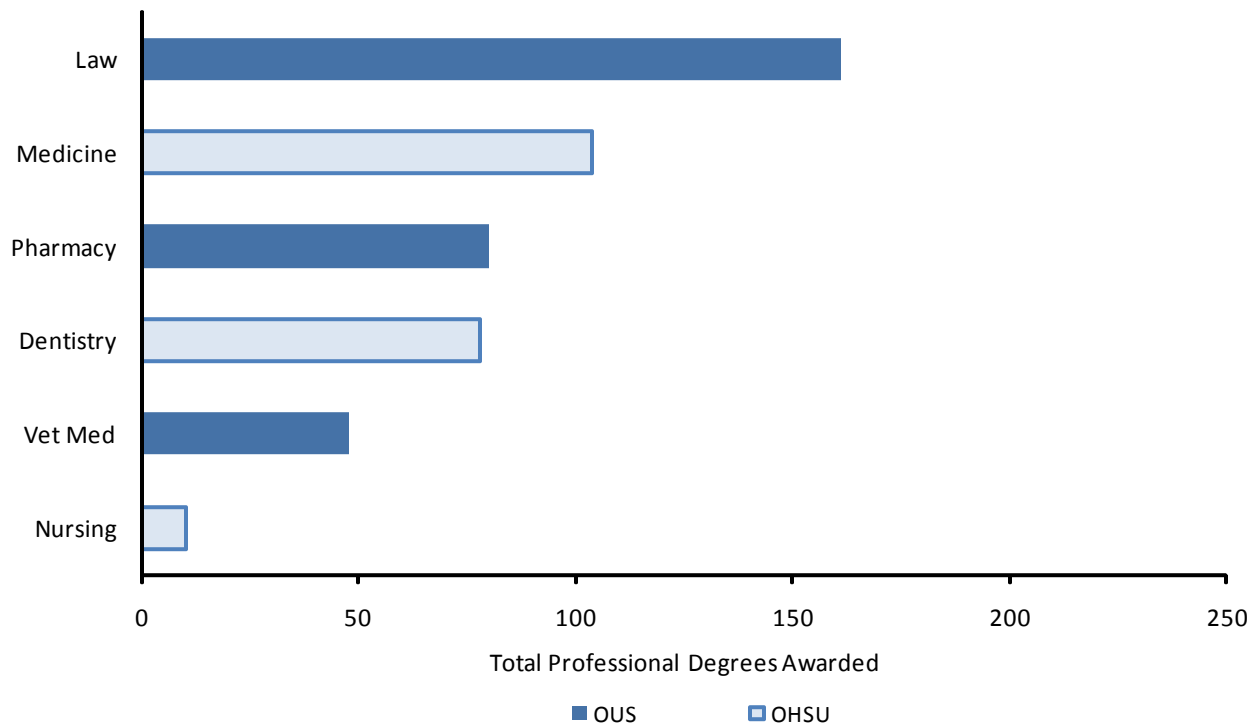
