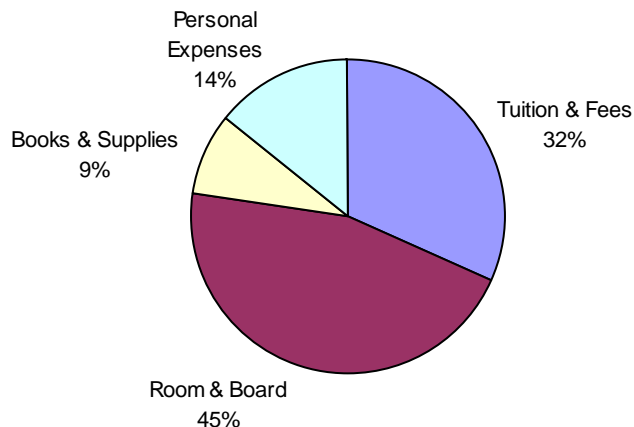

Tuition & Fees, 2001-02

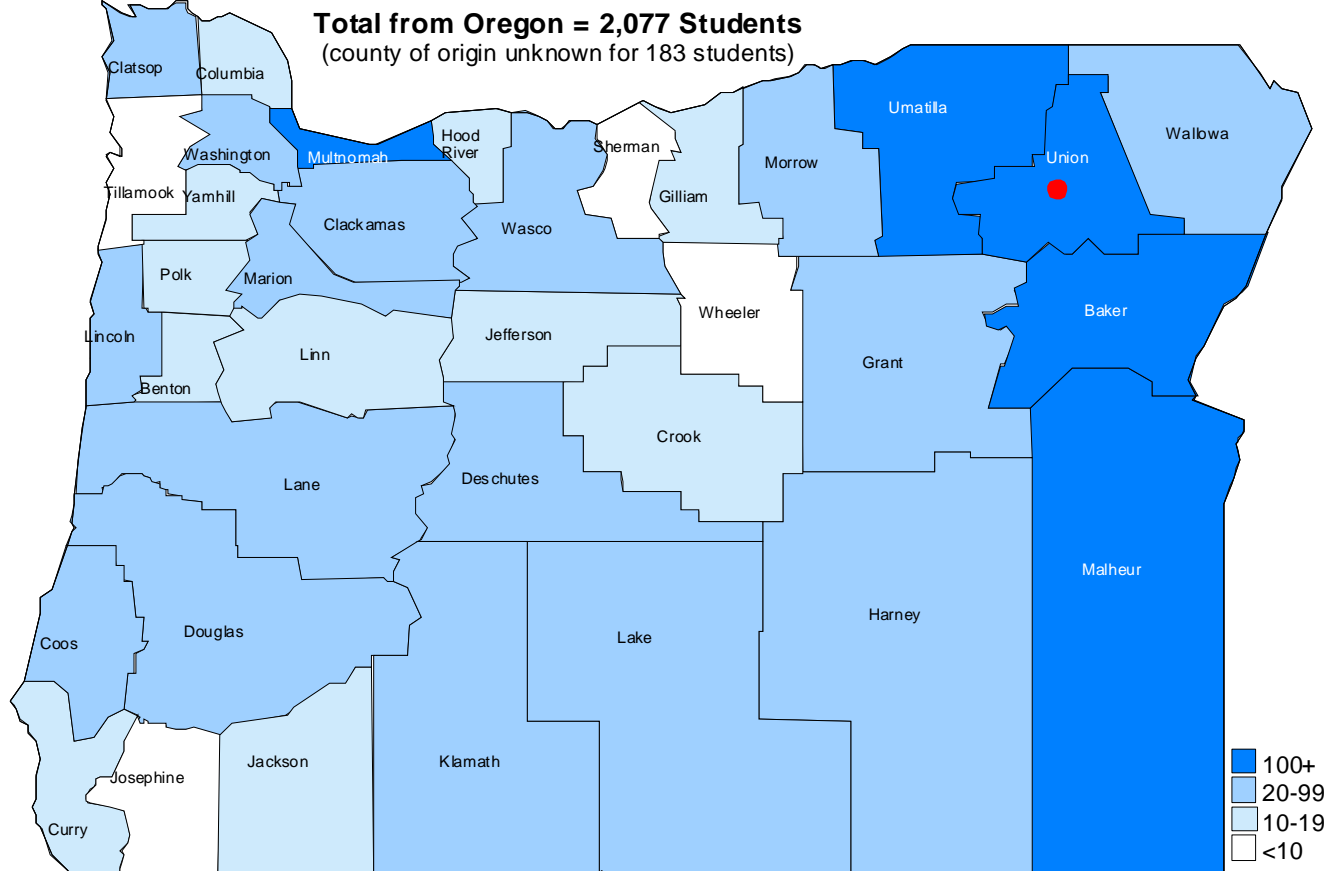
