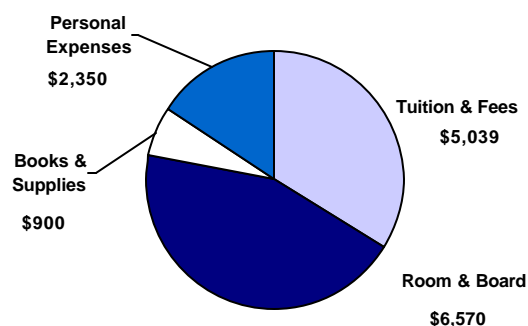

Tuition & Fees, 2003-04

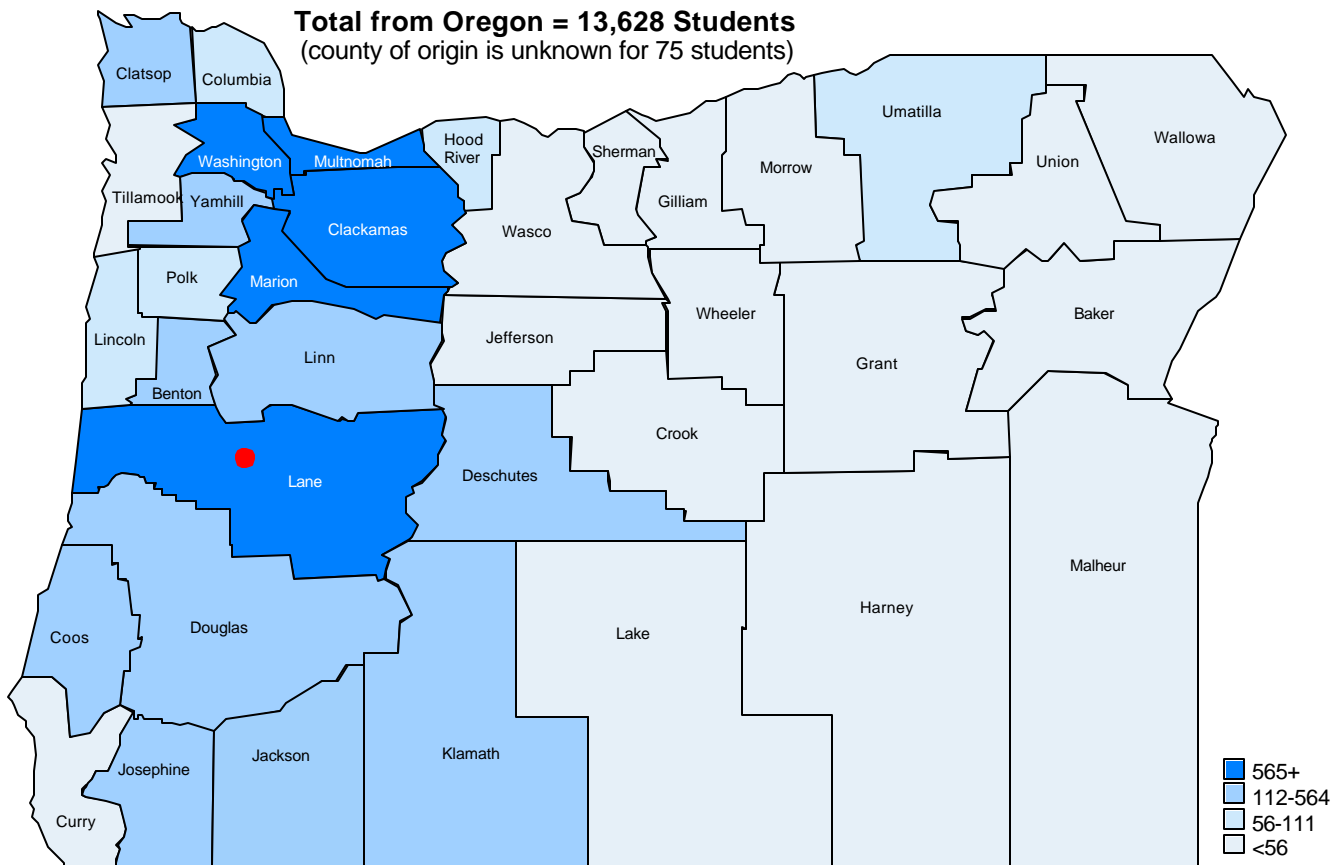
