The middle name of the student.

SEX *Sex*

A code indicating the student's sex.

ETHNIC *Ethnicity*

A code describing the ethnic group with which the student identifies. If a student receives a Minority Tuition Fee Remission, this code must reflect the ethnic group for which the Fee Remission was awarded.

Additional detailed ethnic sub-categories are included with two-character codes under many of the broad-level categories (those having single-character codes). These detailed categories may be used to further describe the student's ethnic origin.

GEOG_ZIP *Geographic Origin, Zip Code*

Zip code of residence at time of admission for the current student level.

GEOG_COUNTY *Geographic Origin, County*

County of residence at the time of admission to the current student level. Must be coded if GEOG_STATE = 'OR'.

GEOG_NATION *Geographic Origin, Nation*

Nation code of residence at the time of admission to the current student level. Use 'XXX' for unknown country.

LEGAL_NATION *Nation of Citizenship*

Nation code of the country of citizenship. Use 'XXX' for unknown country.

CITIZENSHIP *Citizenship*

US = US Citizen

RA = Resident Alien

NR = Nonresident Alien

XX = Unknown (permissible value only for nonadmitted students)

S_STATUS *Student Status*

The student's attendance status at this institution for his/her current student level:

- AS = *New* – First-time admitted to this institution at this degree level (i.e., undergraduate, graduate, nonadmitted undergraduate, nonadmitted graduate).
- CN = *Continuing* – Student attended last academic term (where either spring or summer term may count as the last term during fall term).
- RT = *Returning* – Student has enrolled for courses at this institution during at least one previous academic term, but not the last academic term. During fall term, either spring or summer term may count as the immediate previous term.

S_LEVEL *Student Level*

The level at which the student is admitted or enrolled.

UG = Undergraduate (including postbaccalaureate nongraduate)

GR = Graduate

NU = Nonadmitted Undergraduate

NG = Nonadmitted Graduate

FP = First Professional (e.g., Law, Veterinary Medicine, Medicine, Dentistry)

S_TYPE *Student Type*

The code placing the student into one of the following categories:

- A* = *Freshman* (0-44 credit hours)
- B* = *Sophomore* (45-89 credit hours) and first-year nursing
- C* = *Junior* (90-134 credit hours) and first-year OHSU dental hygiene, and second-year nursing
- D* = *Senior* (135+ credit hours, but no baccalaureate), second-year OHSU dental hygiene, third-year nursing and medical technician
- E = *Registered nurses enrolled in baccalaureate nursing program at the senior level*

RESIDENCY *Residency Status*

Coded for all students including nonadmitted students.

Residency is determined by each institution's Residency Classification Officer and reviewed by the Inter-institutional Residency Committee. Residency rules appear in OAR 580-10.

MAJOR1 *Major 1*

The student's first major as identified by the six-character CIP code.

If the major is "Undeclared", code as '000000'.

MAJOR2 *Major 2*

The student's second major as identified by the six-character CIP code. Only use this field if MAJOR1 is also coded.

MAJOR3 *Major 3*

The student's third major as identified by the six-character CIP code. Only use this field if MAJOR2 is also coded.

MAJOR4 *Major 4*

The student's fourth major as identified by the six-character CIP code. Only use this field if MAJOR3 is also coded.

HS *High School*

CEEB (College Entrance Exam Board) code of the high school where the student graduated. Must be coded for all undergraduates who were admitted from high school.

HS_GRAD_DATE *High School Graduation Rate*

High school graduation date. Must be coded for all undergraduates who were admitted from high school.

HS_GPA *High School GPA*

High School GPA at high school where student graduated on a 0 – 4 scale. Must be coded for all undergraduates who were admitted from high school. Valid values are $HS_GPA > 0$ AND $HS_GPA < 4.5$.

ADMIT_ACAD_YR *Admission Year*

Academic year of admission for student's current degree program or level. For nonadmitted students, the academic year when the student first enrolled at his/her current NU or NG level. The academic year begins with summer and ends with spring.

Example: 200102 is the code for the 2001-02 academic year.

ADMIT_TERM *Admission Term*

Term of admission for student's current student degree program or level. For nonadmitted students, the term when the student first enrolled at his/her current NU or NG level.

00 = summer

10 = fall

20 = winter

30 = spring

ADMIT_CALENDAR *Admission Calendar*

A code designating whether the student was admitted on a quarter or semester calendar.

Q = quarter

S = semester

ADMIT_DECISION *Admission Decision*

A code that identifies the admission decision that led to the current student level ('UG'). Only coded for admitted undergraduate students.

First-time Freshmen

- A1 = High school graduate, high school GPA, subject requirements, SAT or ACT, and at UO and OSU: TSWE or ACT-English
- A2 = High school graduate, SAT or ACT, and subject requirements
- A3 = High school graduate, predicted GPA, subject requirements, SAT or ACT, and UO and OSU: TSWE or ACT-English
- A0 = High school graduate, high school GPA (or predicted GPA or SAT/ACT), achievement tests, SAT or ACT, and at UO and OSU: TSWE or ACT-English
- A4 = A1, A2, A3, or A0 above and college GPA (12 to 23 college credit hours for EOU, OIT, SOU, WOU; 12 to 35 college credit hours for OSU, UO, and SOU; 12 to 29 college credit hours for PSU). Students may exceed these numbers if all credit was earned in high school and/or the term immediately following graduation.
- A5 = 5% Special Admission
- A6 = Other Special Admission
- A7 = Admission by Requirements in Effect For and Prior to 1984-85
- A8 = GED (General Education Development) Test
- A9 = Prescribed Summer Session Program
- AF = Foreign Document/Secondary Record Evaluation and TOEFL
- AX = EOU Only: Special Two-year Program Admission for Ten County Service Area

- AT = College GPA: 24 (EOU, OIT, SOU, WOU) or 36 (OSU, PSU, UO) or more hours of college credit
- AU = College GPA and TOEFL

FOR_LANG_REQ *Foreign Language Requirement*

Flag that identifies whether students met foreign language requirement as first-time freshmen.

Y = Met foreign language requirement

N = Did not meet foreign language requirement

TERM_HRS_ATTEMPT *Term Hours Attempted*

Number of hours attempted for the current term. Exclude audit credit.

TERM_HRS_COMPL *Term Hours Completed*

Number of hours completed for the current term. Exclude audit credit.

Leave blank for the fall week 4 submission.

TERM_GPA *Term GPA*

GPA for the current term just completed. Leave null for 4th week fall submission.

TERM_GPA_HRS *Term GPA Hours*

Hours counted in GPA for the current term just completed. Leave null for 4th week fall submission.

TERM_QP *Term Quality Points*

Quality Points for the current term just completed. Leave null for 4th week fall submission.

INST_HRS *Institutional Hours*

Cumulative institutional hours for the current level. For end-of-term submissions include current term's hours. For fourth week submission include all institutional hours up to, but not including the current term.

INST_GPA_HRS *Institutional GPA Hours*

Cumulative institutional hours for the current level that counted toward the calculation of INST_GPA. For end-of-term submissions include current term's hours. For 4th week submission include all institutional hours up to, but not including the current term.

INST_QP *Institutional GPA Quality Points*

Cumulative institutional quality points for the current level that counted toward the calculation of INST_GPA. For end-of-term fall submission include current term's quality points. For fourth week submission include all institutional quality points up to, but not including the current term.

INST_GPA *Institutional GPA*

Cumulative institutional GPA for the student's current level. For end-of-term submission, should include the current term. For week four submission, should include work up to the current term.

TRANS_EVAL_HRS *Transfer Hours Evaluated*

Cumulative transfer evaluated hours..

TRANS_ACCEPT_HRS *Transfer Hours Accepted*

Cumulative transfer hours accepted.

TRANS_GPA *Transfer GPA*

Cumulative GPA of all accepted transferred credit for the student's current level.

ACAD_STDG_CURR *Academic Standing, Current*

Academic standing for admitted undergraduates *that was in effect during the submission term*. Should be coded for all admitted undergraduates.

G = Good Standing

W = Warning

P = Probation

D = Disqualification

ACAD_STDG_FUTR *Academic Standing, Future*

Academic standing for admitted undergraduates *that reflects the grades earned during the submission term and that will be in effect for the next term*. Leave blank for the fall 4th week submission. Should be coded for all admitted undergraduates for the end-of-term submissions.

G = Good Standing

W = Warning

P = Probation

D = Disqualification
