This table includes a record for each of the students' subject requirements completed in high school that qualify as units to satisfy the OUS subject area requirement for admission. All records in HS\_SUBJ should have matching MPIDMs in STUDENT.

Collected for 4<sup>th</sup> week fall and end of term summer, fall, winter and spring.

## **HS** *High School*

For Oregon high schools, report the complete six-digit CEEB number of the high school. For unknown Oregon high schools, code as '38XXXX'.

For other U.S. high schools report the CEEB number, or if the CEEB code is unknown use the two-digit numeric state code (used in the CEEB codes) followed by 'XXXX'.

For foreign high schools, report '99XXXX'.

The high school subjects required for freshman admission. There will be only one record for each subject requirement per student.

ENGL = English  
MATH = Mathematics  
SCI = Science  
SOC = Social Studies  
SOCGS = Social Studies – Global Studies  
SOCUS = Social Studies – US History  
SPELEC = Electives  
FL = Foreign Language\*
