## ***Summary of Fee and Policy Changes for 2006-07***

The State Board of Higher Education adopted the 2006-07 Academic Year Fee Book at the June 2, 2006 Board meeting with the following anticipated changes in tuition and fees.

### ***Proposed Changes in Tuition and Fees***

The tuition and fee proposals in the 2006-07 Academic Year Fee Book include proposed rate and tuition plateau changes. The increases proposed in the Fee Book comply with the 2005-2007 Legislative Budget Note that undergraduate resident tuition for the system will not increase by more than 3 percent in the first year and 3 percent in the second year of the biennium. Campus resource fee increases for 2006-07 were limited to bring the system into compliance with the 9.1% limitation of gross tuition revenue.

There are a number of substantive changes in tuition and fee policies for the 2006-07 academic year. These changes include:

**OIT** – Oregon Institute of Technology received approval to build the Center for Health Professions. There was an agreement at that time that part of the funding for the added instructional tuition costs would be borne by a differential tuition and fee structure charged to newly admitted students beginning Fall 2006.

Health tuition in academic year 2006-07 will be 5% more than base tuition (\$107 versus \$102 per credit hour) for those required courses in the allied health curricula. General education courses such as math and writing will not be assessed a differential tuition. These charges are applied only to courses that are delivered for the allied health curricula. This additional tuition will not be charged to students who were admitted into the allied health curricula prior to Fall 2006.

The Health Tuition rate will increase in two subsequent steps, in 2007-08 and in 2008-09, rising 5% each year. Since the student population will continue to mature, the health-specific course list will include junior-level classes in 2007-08 and senior-level classes in 2008-09. Students currently admitted and accepted into the allied health curricula will be able to petition to have the rate reduced to the base tuition rate if they believe the Health Tuition rate was inappropriately applied to their situation.

For the 2006-07 academic year, OIT will complete the process of eliminating the tuition plateau. While remaining within the 3% legislative cap, this final step is expected to generate additional revenue that will help offset the significant decline in revenue experienced by OIT in 2005-06.

**OSU** – Oregon State University's Pharmacy (PharmD) program also has a separate tuition schedule and currently charges a separate resource fee. OSU is proposing to eliminate its Pharmacy resource fee and incorporate this fee into tuition. For the 2006-07 academic year, separate tuition schedules were developed for returning and newly admitted students and the per term resource fee was eliminated. The result of this change makes it appear that the Pharmacy tuition rate is increasing by 24%, however, it is actually only increasing by 14%. This increase is necessary to address increasing costs and to avoid significant program cuts.

**PSU** – In the past, Portland State University utilized the “part-time” fee policy for all of its part-time students. This policy allows an institution to charge all part-time students, regardless of actual residency status, resident tuition rates for up to eight (8) credit hours each quarter. The basis for this policy is that institutions that have many part-time or casual students did not have to obtain comprehensive information from part-time students in order to determine residency, thus avoiding the work involved for both the applicants and the institution.

PSU now wants to begin charging all students tuition based on residency status. PSU is planning to phase this policy change in over a two-year period. The first change would be made for admitted students. PSU is projecting that, effective Fall 2006, all admitted, non-resident part-time students would pay non-resident tuition rates for all credit hours taken. Then, in Fall 2007, PSU would begin to charge all part-time students, regardless of admission status, differential rates based on residency status.

**UO** – The UO Law school has a separate tuition schedule and currently charges a required resource fee. For the 2006-07 academic year, it is proposed that the Law School resource fee be merged into tuition, thereby eliminating the resource fee. The result of this change makes it appear that the tuition rate is increasing by approximately 40% for new Law students; however, it is actually only increasing by 5% over the 2005-06 academic year.

**WOU** – To date, Western Oregon University has completed the elimination of the tuition plateau for all students except resident undergraduates. The plateau for resident undergraduate students is being eliminated in 2006-07 to move toward a per credit hour charge based on residency and class status (undergraduate, graduate, or WUE). For 2006-07, resident undergraduate credit hours one through twelve remain unchanged while credit hours thirteen, fourteen and fifteen will be assessed at \$45 per credit, one-half the regular per credit rate. For credit hours sixteen and greater, the regular per credit charge is again assessed. Assuming constant enrollment, these changes keep WOU within the 3% cap on tuition. In Fall 2007, WOU will begin charging all part-time students, regardless of admission status, differential rates based on residency status.

### **Residence Hall and Food Service Charges**

Institutional residence halls and food services operate as auxiliary services. Auxiliary fees and charges are expected to cover the cost of their operations. In recommending residence hall room and board charges for 2006-07, institution administrators estimated residence hall occupancy in relation to enrollment projections and current occupancy patterns.

# **ACADEMIC YEAR TUITION AND FEE POLICIES**

## **INTRODUCTION**

The Academic Year Fee Book adopted by the State Board of Education through Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 580-040-0040 contains the enrollment fee policies that are common to the institutions of the Oregon University System. It also contains policy statements and delegation of authority for a variety of other policies and fees. This document has been developed over the past several decades and has been modified annually as incremental changes have occurred.

## I. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Oregon Legislature grants authority to the State Board of Higher Education to establish tuition and fees for enrollment at Oregon University System institutions. Based on recommendations from the institutions and the Chancellor, the Board annually sets fees for enrollment at the institutions, including:

- Tuition
- Building Fees
- Health Service Fees
- Incidental Fees
- Education Resource Fees
- Residence Hall Room and Board Rates
- Other Special Fees as determined by the Board

The Legislature requires the Board to follow Oregon administrative rule-making procedures when adopting tuition and fees to give adequate notice and opportunity for public comment. Fee policies and rates must be in writing and available to interested parties upon request.

The Board has delegated authority to the institution presidents to establish certain fees, fines, and charges for services and materials, including:

- Laboratory and Course fees
- Fees for workshops
- Instruction fees for self-support courses
- Charges for auxiliary services, e.g. food services, student centers, and parking
- Fines for violation of campus regulations
- Charges for facilities use
- Charges for other materials and services

The Board requires the institutions to follow Oregon administrative rule-making procedures when adopting fees, fines, and charges to give adequate notice and opportunity for public comment. The schedule of charges must be on file in the business office of the institution and also filed with the Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration. Income from such services must be reflected in the institution budget.

## **II. TUITION AND FEE POLICIES**

Enrollment Fees, which are Tuition and Fees that students must pay in the pursuit of their chosen degree, are recommended by the institutions and approved by the Board. The Fees included in this category are: Energy Surcharge Fee, Resource Fee, Building Fee, Health Service Fee, and Incidental Fee. Technology Fees are a form of Resource Fees. The University of Oregon Recreation Center Bond Fee is a special fee. There may be differentials for some of these fees based on residency or some other criteria.

### **A. Tuition Structure and Assessment**

Tuition is established to provide support for instructional programs and instructional support expenditures. Tuition rates vary in general based on student level and residency. In some cases, tuition rates are based on course level or the cost of providing a course.

Tuition rates for students admitted to regular academic programs are based on student classification and residency:

- Student level – Undergraduate and Graduate
- Residency – Resident and Nonresident

Under the Part-time Fee Policy, tuition for students enrolled for eight credit hours or less is assessed by:

- Course level – graduate or undergraduate courses
- Assessed at the resident rate

For Summer Session, tuition may be assessed by:

- Course Level or Student Level
- May be assessed at the resident rate

For Self-Support Courses, tuition may be assessed by:

- Course Level or the Cost of providing the Course
- No residency differential

### **B. Optional Part-Time Fee Policy**

These policies, if adopted by an institution, apply to students enrolled for up to eight credits. The adoption of these policies for part-time students is optional with an institution. An institution that adopts the part-time fee policy will waive residency and admissions requirements for all such students, except that institutions may choose to apply the part-time policy only to non-matriculated (non-degree) students.

Part-time students carrying eight or fewer credits will be assessed the Tuition based upon the level of the course taken. Undergraduate courses will be assessed at the resident undergraduate rate, and graduate courses will be assessed at the resident graduate rate.

### **C. Students in Self-Support Courses for Credit - Other than Summer Session**

These policies apply to students in credit-bearing courses that are identified by the institution to be supported by tuition and fee revenue and accounted for separately. Charges for self-support courses are set at levels necessary to cover the direct costs of providing the course.

These policies do not apply to Summer Session courses (see Summer Session Fee Book for summer fees and policies).

1. Self-support Tuition and Fees will be assessed to participating students regardless of the enrollment fees paid for other courses.
2. Self-support Course Fees are established by the institution. Although individual courses may not be direct cost supporting, the rate of charge must be sufficient to assure that the total program of courses at an institution is direct cost supporting. Assessment of Resource Fees for self-support courses is an institutional decision.
3. No residency classification is required for self-support credit courses.
4. The staff, and graduate assistant fee privileges do not apply to self-support courses other than the regular summer session program. Exceptions may be allowed by the institution for courses deemed to have met the condition of self-support. (See Summer Session Fee Book for summer fee privileges.) The OUS/School Partnership Co-Pay fee policy may apply to self-support courses.

#### ***D. Postbaccalaureate, Nongraduate Student Classification***

A holder of an accredited baccalaureate degree who has not been admitted to a graduate degree program and who submits an official application for admission to pursue a second baccalaureate degree or enroll in course work not to be used for graduate credit will be called a *postbaccalaureate, nongraduate student* and will be assessed tuition at undergraduate rates.

Fees and policies applicable under the part-time fee policy shall prevail when a student classified as a postbaccalaureate, nongraduate enrolls for eight or fewer credits at an institution that has adopted the part-time student policy.

Baccalaureate degree holders who are admitted to postbaccalaureate, nongraduate status at undergraduate tuition rates are precluded from claiming graduate credits for graduate courses taken while in that status. However, individual institutions may allow the reservation of not more than six of their graduate credits per term to apply in their institution's graduate programs. Graduate credits reserved in combination as an undergraduate and postbaccalaureate, nongraduate cannot exceed 15 credits. Baccalaureate degree holders who are not admitted to postbaccalaureate, nongraduate status will be assessed graduate tuition rates.

Students who are admitted to an advanced degree program may convert to postbaccalaureate, nongraduate student status only if the graduate degree has been awarded, if a student has been dropped from the degree program by the institution, or upon a request approved by the dean of the Graduate School for voluntary relinquishment of graduate status.

Students in the education programs who are admitted to the 45-hour standard norm certificate program are not eligible for the postbaccalaureate, nongraduate student status. Graduate tuition rates are applicable whether or not students in the program seek graduate credit.

***E. Oregon Center for Advanced Technology Education***

The Oregon Center for Advanced Technology Education (OCATE) coordinates graduate level engineering courses for the high technology industry. OCATE is not a separate institution. Originally OCATE was a division of the Office of the State Board of Higher Education. In 2005 the State Board of Higher Education moved the administrative responsibilities to PSU. Tuition and fees charged are per contracts established with the OUS institution conducting the class.

### **III. REDUCED TUITION RATES**

#### ***A. Western Undergraduate Exchange Tuition Rate***

Tuition for students admitted under the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program will be assessed 150 percent of the prevailing resident undergraduate tuition rate.

The WUE program allows first-time enrolling, nonresident undergraduate students from participating states to pay 150 percent of resident tuition when enrolled in selected programs at Oregon University System institutions. Students participating in this program must maintain enrollment in these designated programs to retain qualification. The time spent as a WUE student cannot apply toward residency status. Students previously or currently enrolled in System schools are not eligible for this program. Neither the institutions nor the Oregon University System is obligated to notify prospective, admitted, or enrolled students who are eligible for this program. Institutions that implement this program must report WUE enrollment as directed, and validate WUE students quarter to quarter.

#### ***B. Academic and Classified Staff Tuition***

Per credit hour

Per term: 25% of the Resident Undergraduate Tuition Rate of the teaching institution, rounded to the nearest dollar.

Per semester: 150% of the Resident Undergraduate Per Term Staff Tuition Rate of the teaching institution, rounded to the nearest dollar.

1. On approval of the president or designee of the teaching institution and with the concurrence of the employee's immediate supervisor, the staff fee is available to employees appointed at half-time or more (not including temporary classified employees, graduate assistants, or other student employees). To qualify for this fee, the staff member must meet the criteria no later than the first day of classes of the term of enrollment. The maximum number of credits to which the staff fee may apply is 12 credits per quarter or per semester. See exception for retired employees and staff members on leave, Section d (OAR 580-022-0030).
2. Fee Calculation: Employees enrolled for more than 12 credits in one term will pay for each additional credit at the campus designated per credit Tuition rate applicable to resident undergraduate or graduate students, dependent upon the employee's degree status.

Charges for Building Fee, Health Service Fee, and Incidental Fee do not apply; nor are staff members entitled to Health Service or Incidental Fee services through this program.

No Application Fee will be required for staff members who are eligible for the staff fee rate.

Resource Fees do apply.

No breakage or other deposit is required of staff members.

Staff fees are not applicable to courses leading to D.V.M. degree at Oregon State University.

Employees in Centralized Activities must have approval of the Chancellor or designee before registering for credit at the staff fee rate.

For purposes of this rule, the term "employee" may include persons with full-time courtesy appointments who provide a benefit to the institution in the form of teaching, research, or counseling, under the direction of the institution and using the facilities of the institution.

3. Retired employees and staff members on leave are eligible for staff fee privileges. Subject to the approval of the president of the teaching institution, the maximum credit limitation may be waived for retired employees and for staff members on leave. However, the staff fee will be required. See exception under Senior Citizen Tuition.
4. Staff members who use the staff fee for courses away from their home institution are subject to staff fee policies and procedures of the instructing institution.
5. Staff members may be permitted to take noncredit courses at approximately one-third of the fee assessed to other registrants. Teaching units are not required to extend staff fees for noncredit courses, self-sustaining workshops, or self-support credit courses.
6. Staff members on furlough or lay-off status may be eligible for staff fees in accordance with provisions of a collective bargaining agreement.

*Note: There is no fee plateau at any campus for staff members or retired staff.*

7. No fee shall be assessed to courses enrolled in by staff members with a grading option of 'audit'. Attendance under such condition must be with the instructor's consent and on a space-available basis. Institutions are required to maintain a record of the courses audited. Courses approved for audit by the instructor confer no credit to the student, are not charged staff fee rates or regular tuition, and may be used in addition to staff fee privileges during a term. However, this provision cannot be subdivided in conjunction with the Employee Family Member and Domestic Partner Transfer provisions.

### **C. Employee Family Member and Domestic Partner Tuition and Fees**

Per credit hour

Per term: 25% of the Resident Undergraduate Tuition Rate of the teaching institution, rounded to the nearest dollar.

Per semester: 150% of the Resident Undergraduate Per Term Staff Tuition Rate of the teaching institution, rounded to the nearest dollar.

To improve the recruitment and retention of high quality faculty and staff within the Oregon Department of Higher Education, the staff fee policy is extended to qualified family members and domestic partners on a limited basis (OAR 580-022-0031).

1. The staff fee provisions may be transferred to a qualified family member or domestic partner of employees appointed at half time or more (not including temporary classified employees, graduate assistants, or other student employees). Employee qualification will be verified through Human Resource System records. To qualify for this fee, the family member or domestic partner must meet the criteria no later than the first day of classes of the term of enrollment. For purposes of this policy, the term "family" includes spouse and dependent children in accordance with IRS Code and domestic partner as defined per Section One of the Public Employees Benefit Board Affidavit of Domestic Partnership and dependent children of domestic partner. The employee will verify the qualification of the family member or domestic partner. The maximum number of credits to which the staff fee may apply is 12 credits per quarter or per semester.

Only one staff member, family member or domestic partner within a family may use the staff fee benefit per term. The benefit may not be subdivided during a term.

The benefit is portable (i.e., may be utilized at any Oregon University System institution); however, Presidents of Oregon University System institutions may exclude programs from the policy. A list of excluded programs must be filed with the institution's Registrars office prior to the first day of Registration for a term.

*Note:* There is no fee plateau at any campus for staff members, retired staff, domestic partners, or eligible dependents.

2. Fee Calculation: The qualified family member or domestic partner enrolled for more than twelve (12) credits in one term must pay for additional credit at the per credit tuition rate applicable to resident undergraduate or graduate students, depending upon the family member's or domestic partner's degree status. All applicable credits will be charged at the relevant resident tuition rate. Fees for credits in excess of twelve (12) shall be at the standard institutional rate. There will be no tuition plateau.

Charges for all other enrollment fees apply, (except for courses being taken in an audit status). These include, but are not limited to: Building Fee, Resource Fees, Health Service Fee, and Incidental Fee. The participating family member or domestic partner is entitled to all associated services.

Breakage and other required deposits are required of the participating family member or domestic partner.

3. The transfer of staff fee benefits is not available for retired employees.
4. Qualified family members or domestic partners of staff members who use the staff fee for courses away from the employee's employing institution are subject to staff fee policies and procedures of the instructing institution.
5. Qualified family members or domestic partners of staff members may be permitted to take noncredit courses at approximately one-third of the fee assessed to other registrants. Teaching units are not required to extend staff fees for noncredit courses, self-sustaining workshops, or self-supported credit courses.
6. Eligibility of employees on furlough or lay-off status is subject to applicable collective bargaining agreements.
7. No fee shall be assessed to courses enrolled in by the family member or domestic partner with a grading option of 'audit'. Attendance under such condition must be with the instructor's consent and on a space-available basis. Institutions are required to maintain a record of the courses audited. Courses approved for audit by the instructor confer no credit to the student, are not charged staff fee rates or regular tuition, and may be used in addition to staff fee privileges during a term. However, this provision cannot be subdivided in conjunction with the Staff Fee Policy provisions.

*Administrative Authority: OAR 580-022-0031 Transfer of Staff Fee Privileges*

#### **D. Graduate Assistants**

Graduate students appointed by the institution and paid at established institutional salary rates as graduate teaching assistants, graduate research assistants, or graduate fellows are exempt from the payment of the Tuition up to the first 16 credits per term subject to institutional policy. The graduate student exemption from payment of the Tuition does not apply to courses leading to the D.V.M. degree at Oregon State University. Appointment as an assistant may not be for less than .15 FTE for the term of appointment.

The Tuition will be assessed to the employing account or department within the institution, not to exceed the graduate resident, full-time student Tuition per term. When an assistant is authorized to exceed 16 credits per term, the institution shall charge the assistant the resident overload Tuition for the excess credits. The enrollment privilege does not apply to self-support courses.

If an assistant has been on an academic year appointment, serving in that appointment spring term, and the institution intends to reappoint the assistant in the following fall term, the assistant may exercise the study privilege during the interim summer term upon approval of the institution.

Graduate assistants are assessed and are individually responsible for payment of the Building, Health, Incidental, and Resource Fees approved for the institution and program in which they are enrolled at the credit hour level carried, and at rates applicable to graduate students. Overload Tuition is assessed at the resident graduate student Tuition rate for each overload hour.

*Administrative Authority: OAR 580-022-0030 Staff Fee Privileges*

**E. Resident Oregon Senior Citizen**

Per Credit Hour .....No Charge

Resident Oregon senior citizens age 65 or older who are residents of Oregon may attend classes on a space-available basis. Charges for special materials, if any, will be made.

Incidental Fee services are not provided.

The senior citizen program is designed for persons not seeking credit or working toward a degree. If credit is sought, fees will be assessed as provided under applicable tuition schedules, and records will be maintained.

**F. Auditors**

Students enrolled in a combination of credit and audit courses or audit only will be assessed for the total credits under the credit tuition and fee schedule appropriate to their classification and residency.

**G. University/School Partnership Co-Pay Program**

School districts having contracts with the Oregon University System institutions to supervise educator professionals preparing for Oregon licensure may exercise these provisions.

Earning the Co-Pay

For each permissible activity provided under contract with a cooperating district (see 'a' and 'b' below), a district earns a co-pay privilege to register any licensed educational professional employed by the district at the Oregon University System co-pay fee rate. The rate should be one-third of the tuition charged for the course. Institutions with current contractual obligations may elect to defer compliance of the rate until expiration of the existing contract. A "co-pay privilege" allows one individual to register for up to 8 quarter credit hours in the term it is used. The total reduced fee credits awarded for practica and student teaching may not exceed 11 in a year, per each university student provided services by the district.

- a. Supervised full-time student teaching: Co-pay privileges of 5 credit hours may be awarded for supervision of the final full-time student teaching per quarter. Student teaching is the culminating, full-time supervised teaching experience provided for students completing a program approved by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, leading to Initial Licensure in one or more of four authorizations: Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle, and High School; and specialty endorsements.
- b. Experiential preparatory practica or part-time student teaching: Co-pay privileges of 3 credit hours may be awarded for supervision of students in experiential preparatory practica or part-time student teaching per academic quarter. These are practica assigned to or required of the student prior to or concurrent with student teaching and block practica and/or other miscellaneous practica offered by colleges and divisions of education for students completing a program approved by the Teacher Standards and

Practices Commission, leading to Initial Licensure in one or more of four authorizations: Early Childhood, Elementary, Middle, and High School; and specialty endorsements.

#### Redeeming Reduced Fee Credits

- c. Earned co-pay privileges must be used by a licensed educator professional employed by the school district within five successive academic quarters (including summer session) following the quarter in which the supervision is provided, after which time the co-pay privilege is void.
- d. The co-pay fee is applicable only up to 8 credit hours in any academic quarter for any one licensed educator professional, including summer session, even though the district may have earned two or more enrollment privileges, or if the licensed educator professional using the privilege enrolls for fewer than 8 credits. Unused portions of an enrollment privilege may not be carried to another term or used by another teacher.
- e. A co-pay privilege may be used during any academic term (including summer session) at the issuing institution within the Oregon University System, which has a teacher preparation program. Institutions may enter into “partnerships of trade” with any sister institution if they are willing to accept vouchers from other institutions.
- f. Each institution may set limits on courses available for those redeeming vouchers/co-pays (for example, courses in summer session, distance education, continuing licensure, continuing/extended education). Each institution will indicate on the voucher the existence of restrictions.
- g. The co-pay privilege may also be redeemed by an administrator, counselor, or other licensed educator professional in a cooperating district.
- h. Institutions with current contractual obligations may elect to defer compliance of the rate until the expiration of the existing contract.

#### Other Provisions

- i. If a licensed educator professional using a co-pay privilege registers for 8 hours or fewer and desires the in-residence services provided by the Health Service and Incidental Fee, the licensed educator professional may elect those services by paying the appropriate fee for the number of hours enrolled. If the licensed educator professional using the co-pay privilege registers for more than 8 credit hours, the first 8 hours may be taken at the institution’s co-pay rate. Hours in excess of 8 shall be at the appropriate credit hour rate (graduate or undergraduate, resident or nonresident) and the institution shall charge all Enrollment Fees applicable to the total number of hours for which the licensed educator professional is registering.
- j. Each institution may, at its discretion, extend to the eligible district licensed educator professional other privileges such as use of the institution library, access to campus parking, and admission to campus events at faculty and staff rates, provided that such extended privileges do not exceed the benefits made available to the faculty and staff of the institution.

## **H. Approved Programmatic Fee Remission Programs**

Fee remissions are funded through institution resources. The policies governing each fee remission program specify the extent to which the enrollment fees are to be reduced under each program. The combined total fee remissions for a student may not exceed the total enrollment fees for that student.

The following are summaries of the authorized fee remission programs:

### 1. *Diversity Programs*

#### a. Oregon University System Educational Diversity Initiative

The Educational Diversity Initiative replaces three fee remission programs: the Minority Achievement Scholarship Program for First-Time Freshmen, Underrepresented Minorities Achievement Scholarship Program, and the Oregon Laurels Program. Students who were originally admitted in the original programs will continue under those program guidelines. New students admitted effective Fall 1998 will come under the policies of the Educational Diversity Initiative. These original three programs were completely phased out and eliminated from the Fee Book by the Board on July 19, 2002.

*Criteria:* This program is open to all students, resident or nonresident, undergraduate or graduate. Under the guidelines approved by the Board on October 17, 1997, each campus may have a program of its own design and may describe the program in the manner it wishes. Similarly, the program may consider different factors in making awards and may offer one or more tuition and fee remission programs as long as it maintains its commitment to diversity. Under these guidelines, campuses may consider different factors in support of their educational mission.

*Awards:* Rather than a prescribed allocation of funds for educational diversity fee remissions, each institution has the discretion to determine the amount to be remitted as well as its allocation schedule. Campuses may make partial or full waivers based on need or to expand the number of students who receive at least some support. Awards are not transferable. Students may not take a tuition remission with them if they move to another OUS institution, but will be evaluated based on the receiving school's educational diversity needs.

#### b. Portland Teacher Program.

*Criteria:* This is a cooperative effort between the Portland Public Schools, Portland Community College, and Portland State University. This program is for students who complete their Portland Community College education and enroll at Portland State University to complete the final stages of teacher preparation.

*Awards:* Awards will consist of a remission of all Enrollment Fees (Tuition, Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees). This program is administered according to policies adopted by the Board, November 16, 1989.

### 2. *International Cultural Service Program*

#### a. International Fee Remission Program

*Criteria:* This program is for students who are undergraduate or graduate with foreign student status.

*Awards:* Awards may vary in amount but cannot exceed the total nonresident undergraduate or graduate Enrollment Fees (Tuition, Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees). Remission of the Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees is at the institution's option.

b. Cultural Service Program

*Criteria:* This program is for students who are undergraduate or graduate with foreign student status; who are competitively selected on the basis of academically meritorious achievement; and who fulfill community service requirements of the program while receiving the award.

*Awards:* Awards may vary in amount but cannot exceed the total nonresident undergraduate or graduate Enrollment Fees (Tuition, Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees). Remission of the Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees is at the institution's option.

3. *International Exchanges*

a. International OUS Exchange Program

*Criteria:* This program is for students who are attending Oregon University System institutions as a part of an approved system wide exchange program.

*Awards:* Awards may consist of remission of all or some of the Enrollment Fees, depending upon the reciprocal agreement under which the student is enrolled.

b. International Institution Exchange Program

*Criteria:* This program is for students who are attending Oregon University System institutions as a part of a Board-approved institution exchange program.

*Awards:* Awards may consist of remission of all or some of the Enrollment Fees, depending upon the reciprocal agreement under which the student is enrolled.

4. *Contract and Grant*

a. Contract and Grant: Academic Year

*Criteria:* This provision is for students who participate in specific courses or programs during the academic year funded by grant or contract with an outside agency or firm.

*Awards:* Awards are generally for remission of the Tuition and any applicable Resource Fees only, depending upon agreement with the granting agency.

b. Contract and Grant: Summer Session

*Criteria:* This provision is for students who participate in specific courses or programs during the summer session funded by grant or contract with an outside agency or firm.

*Awards:* Awards are generally for remission of the Tuition and any applicable Resource Fees only, depending upon agreement with the granting agency.

5. *OUS Supplemental Tuition Grant*

*Criteria:* The OUS Supplemental Tuition Grant is a need-based tuition grant program available to qualified Oregon resident students.

*Awards:* These supplemental tuition grants may vary at institutional discretion but may not exceed the total Tuition assessed for the regular academic year.

6. *VOYAGER Fee Remission*

*Criteria:* The VOYAGER fee remissions are for Oregon residents (OAR 580-010-02- to 045) who are members of the National Guard or Reserves and were deployed in an area of military combat since September 11, 2001. This fee remission is for full time students pursuing their initial bachelor's degree. Students must submit a Free Application for Federal Student Assistance annually and continue to maintain satisfactory academic progress to maintain eligibility.

*Awards:* Award is the difference between the National Guard and Reserves tuition benefit of \$4,500 and total enrollment fees. Students are responsible for securing the National Guard or Reserves tuition benefit. Duration of the VOYAGER award is no longer than four years excepting those five-year degree programs as documented in the campus general catalogs. Students may not earn more than fifteen credits above the minimum number of credits required by the degree to maintain eligibility.

7. *Other Remission Programs*

Institutions may create individual institution fee remission programs to address enrollment management and financial aid program needs. The institution will report to the Board on the creation of each program following guidelines approved by the Board.

*Awards:* Awards may vary in amount but cannot exceed the total nonresident undergraduate or graduate Enrollment Fees (Tuition, Resource, Building, Incidental, and Health Service Fees).

## IV. FEE POLICIES

### A. *Incidental Fee*

The incidental fee is assessed to provide support for student activities. Student committees make recommendations for the amount and use of fees on each campus. In some instances, the student committee recommendations are supported by general campus student referenda. The funds generated by this fee are to be used for “student union activities, educational, cultural, and student government activities, and athletic activities.” The president of each institution reviews the student committee recommendations and submits recommendations to the Chancellor, who, after review, submits proposals to the Board. There are fewer incidental fee supported activities during the summer term, resulting in significantly lower rates than those assessed during the academic year.

An institution approves the level of the Incidental Fee for students carrying eight credits or fewer.

*Statutory Authority: ORS 351.070 (3)(d) Board Powers – Incidental Fees*

*Administrative Authority: OAR 580-010-0090 Incidental Fee Guidelines and Process*

### B. *Health Services Fee*

This fee is used to support each institution’s student health services, which are operated similarly to auxiliary services. Generally, rate increases reflect the institutions' efforts to maintain the self-support nature of these services, including the cost of health insurance policies. During summer sessions, student health services operations function at reduced levels or are not provided at all.

An institution may determine whether to make health service privileges available to students carrying eight credits or fewer and whether the students have the option of participating in the health service program.

*Administrative Authority: OAR 580-011-0005 Student Health Services*

### C. *Building Fee*

Building Fee.....Up to \$45.00/per term

The building fee is the same for all institutions. ORS 351.170 allows OUS to assess up to \$45 per student per term to finance debt service for construction associated with student centers, health centers, and recreational facilities constructed through the issuance of Article XI-F(1) bonds. A pro rata fee is assessed on part-time students, except for those enrolled exclusively in self-support courses or certain federal and foreign study programs.

*Statutory Authority: ORS 351.170 Charges for Use of Buildings*

### D. *Resource Fee*

Resource fees have three forms: *universal fees*, assessed to all students; *program fees*, assessed to students admitted to particular academic programs; and, *one-time fees* for first-term students. Students enrolled under the part-time student fee policy are subject to the resource fees appropriate to specific courses taken. Institutions may propose new resource fees for approval by the Board. Institutions have the option of assessing resource fees during the summer session at rates comparable to those assessed in the preceding academic year.

1. A Resource Fee is an Enrollment Fee assessed to students admitted to, or enrolled in a school, college, department, or degree program. It may be assessed to certain classes of students, such as all freshmen, seniors, graduates, etc., or to students admitted to, or enrolled in a degree program, such as business, engineering, law, etc.
2. A Resource Fee is not a Laboratory or Course Fee, and cannot be applied as such. However, for those students enrolled under the part-time student fee policy and not admitted to the institution or program, the institution may assess the student a Resource Fee if that student is enrolled in a course offered by a school, college, or degree program that assesses a Resource Fee to admitted or enrolled students. For example: a part-time student enrolled at Portland State University taking a course in the College of Engineering, if that college has a Resource Fee for admitted or enrolled students, would be assessed the Resource Fee.
3. Institutions will determine the number and level of Resource Fees to be assessed. The institution must submit its request for a Resource Fee to the Chancellor to be submitted to the Board of Higher Education for approval in accordance with the procedures established for approval of the Academic Year Fee Book.

**E. Recreation/Fitness Center Fee**

A Recreation/Fitness Center Fee was assessed to University of Oregon students beginning Fall term 1998. This fee will be \$15.25 per term per student, prorated by credit hour for students enrolled for less than full time. It will be used for the renovation and expansion of the Esslinger Hall facilities. It was originally endorsed by student referendum in the spring of 1995 with the expectation the fee would remain at \$15.25 per student per term for 30 years. The Board has the authority to revise this fee as necessary to accommodate the requirements of the related project. The Board originally adopted this fee in July 1997.

**F. Energy Surcharge Fee**

Energy Surcharge Fee..... Up to \$40.00/per term

Originally authorized in 2001-02, the Energy Surcharge was created to address a critical increase in energy costs to OUS institutions. Electricity and natural gas are essential to the operation of the campuses and significant cost factors in their operations. Reports indicated the rates of increase would be substantial enough as to impose a severe financial burden on the institutions, affecting their ability to serve the current student populations.

The Board will review the need for any surcharges, annually, at the time of adopting the Academic Year Fee Book. For Fall 2006 two institutions are authorized to implement energy surcharge fees: EOU and UO.

**G. Application Fee**

Institutional.....Up to \$100.00

Each institution may determine the amount of the application fee within the above-stated range and establish policies governing the conditions under which application fees will be required. Institutions may assess additional application fees for admission to selected programs or schools within their institution.

In instances where an application is received without the Application Fee, request will be made for the Application Fee, and the fee must be received before the application will be evaluated.

Application Fees are not refundable.

#### ***H. Application Fee Deferral Program***

Institutional executives may, upon request, defer the Application Fee for first-time freshmen or transfer students who meet the following requirements:

- a. At the time of application, meet family income and general program eligibility requirements for participation in either:
  - 1) Free or reduced school lunch program;
  - 2) TRIO-type college preparatory programs (e.g., Upward Bound, Talent Search, EOC, HEP); or
  - 3) Oregon or other U.S. public assistance program whether or not the student was ever actually a program participant.
- b. Complete the official University System admission Application Fee deferral form that requires the signature of a school official, special program official, or University System official and submit it at the time of application.

Application Fees deferred under this provision become payable upon the student's enrollment and receipt of financial aid funds. If a student does not complete the application process or does not enroll, the Application Fee is canceled.

Students residing outside the United States at the time of their application must prove to the satisfaction of institutional officials that they would meet comparable eligibility guidelines if they applied in their country of residence.

## **V. FEES, FINES, AND CHARGES ESTABLISHED BY THE INSTITUTIONS**

This Fee Book does not include the special fees, fines, and charges that institutions may establish under the authority delegated by the State Board, including fees that concern only one institution or that are levied for services to non-students. Special fees, fines, and charges are not to substitute for Tuition, Incidental Fees, or other fees established by the Board. Fees that may be established by the institutions are described below.

### ***A. Fees for Instruction Related Services***

This Fee Book does not establish Laboratory or Course Fees that concern only one institution. The Laboratory or Course Fees must be published in the institution's catalogue and/or time schedule of classes. Laboratory or Course Fees are limited to institutional sale to students of equipment, materials, or services required as a part of course instruction where the equipment or material:

- 1) Is retained as the personal property of the student at the conclusion of the course.
- 2) Is not readily available for purchase through the bookstore or other external source.

The service is essentially the equivalent of textbooks as a tool of instruction (such as a charge for film rental in a course in cinematic art or travel to field sites for certain courses).

Approval will not be given for Laboratory or Course Fees that constitute a charge for the use of institution owned equipment, for specimens, for software licenses or other microcomputer application charges for goods or services not retained by the student, or for other materials and supplies consumed in the instruction process, except for certain non-required physical education courses that involve use of non-state-owned facilities or expensive equipment.

### ***B. Fees for Non-Instruction Related Services and Materials***

The Board requires that the level of charges should be sufficient to ensure recovery of the cost of providing the services and materials. These include charges for auxiliary services, e.g. food services, student centers, parking, and bookstores; charges for facilities use; and, charges for other materials and services.

The institutions may also set the level of fines for violation of campus regulations.

## **VI. REFUNDS, WAIVERS, AND ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE POLICIES**

### ***A. Refund Policy***

Refund policies for course load reduction or withdrawal are separately developed by each campus and adopted under institution fees and charges procedures. Refunds may be granted to students in accordance with the refund schedule on file with the registrars office or business office. This schedule shall be prepared annually.

Any student with orders to report for active military duty may withdraw at any time during the term and receive a full refund. If sufficient course work has been accomplished and the instructor feels justified in granting credit for the course work completed, credit may be granted and no refund will be given.

### ***B. Waiver of Certain Student Fees***

Certain student fee charges may be waived when regulations of federal agencies or contract agreements preclude the assessment of those fees.

### ***C. Institution Authority to Adjust Charges***

Authorized institution officials may make tuition refunds and waive fines or charges that result from circumstances beyond the student's control or are for the best interest of the institution.

### ***D. Revolving Charge Accounts Policy***

Institutions offering extended payment terms utilizing a revolving charge account method adopt rules creating the Revolving Charge Account Plan, and describe the terms and conditions applicable to the Plan.

Transactions covered by the Plan may include (by way of description and not limitation) tuition, fees, housing charges and other obligations primarily involving students; facilities rentals, lease agreements, program user charges and other transactions with non-students; and fines and penalties, incurred by anyone.

If adopted, institutional rules shall:

- 1) Describe the interest to be charged, as well as service charges, collection and other fees and costs, if any, and penalties that would apply should an account become delinquent;
- 2) Provide for an agreement to be signed by the obligor, the form of which shall be approved by the Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration; the institution shall use its best efforts to have the agreement signed, except for debts arising from fines, penalties and the like; and
- 3) Provide that tuition and fees incurred in any given term be paid in full prior to enrollment in any subsequent term.

*Administrative Authority: OAR 580-040-0041 - Revolving Charge Accounts Policy*

### ***E. Interest on Overdue Accounts***

Institutions may, pursuant to an institutionally adopted rule, charge nine percent interest on all liquidated debts that are past due. A liquidated debt is one in which the amount owed is certain, e.g., a standard fee or a debt based on a promissory note.

Where the institution so provides by administrative rule and a contract or note signed by the obligor so specifies, the institute may charge not more than 12 percent interest on the obligation evidenced by the signed note or contract.

Institutions may not charge interest under both subsection 1 and 2 simultaneously on a single obligation; in no event shall the institution charge more than 12 percent interest.

Institution rules may provide for interest charges to begin immediately following the date on which a debt becomes overdue or after a specified waiting period.

## VIII. ANNUAL HOUSING AND BOARD RATES AND POLICIES

Residence halls are self-supporting auxiliary enterprises that furnish essential services to students and authorized persons attending educational activities supported by the institution. In addition to living quarters and meal service, residence halls provide counseling, advising, and social and recreational programs that augment the instructional programs. The rates of charge are established at levels that cover the cost of the service, including the proportionate share of the debt service associated with the residence hall and food service activities at the respective institutions.

Residence Hall rates are proposed annually by the institutions and approved by the State Board of Higher Education. The institutions establish fee policies related to housing, including length of contracts, installment payments, late fees, pro-ration of fees, and charges for vacation periods. The institutions also set rates for optional services such as telephones, refrigerators, and laundry.

### **A. Application Fee/Deposit, Cancellation, and Refund Policies**

Application Fee/Deposit ..... Up to \$150  
An application fee, deposit or combination thereof, may be assessed. Rate, room reservation, cancellation, and refund policies are established and approved by each institution.

### **B. Pro-ration of Annual Charges by Term**

### **C. Responsibility for Damages**

The student is required to pay all charges for damages to institutional property and public areas for which the student is responsible in accordance with institution policy.

### **D. Family, Cooperative, and Miscellaneous Housing Rates**

Each institution establishes the rental rates, room and board charges, and related deposits charged to student occupants of institution owned and operated family, cooperative, and miscellaneous housing.

### **E. Residence Hall Rates**

The State Board of Higher Education has the authority and reserves the right to modify charges during the year.
