What It Is:	An international mutual fund.
Goal:	Seeks to provide long-term capital appreciation.
What it invests in:	Primarily invests in emerging markets equity securities that the fund manager deems to be value stocks at the time of purchase. Securities are considered value stocks primarily because a company's shares have a high book value in relation to their market value. In assessing value, additional factors such as price to cash flow or price to earnings ratios may be considered, as well as economic conditions and developments in the issuer's industry.
