Background

Tuition rates for students admitted to academic programs are established via student classification (undergraduate, graduate and doctoral), residency, and credit hours taken. Tuition revenue supports the administrative and instruction costs of each OUS institution and vary based on factors including class sizes, faculty salaries, specialized programs and equipment as well as facilities required to teach courses. There are three basic tuition and fee structures at OUS institutions: the regular Academic Year, Summer Session, and Continuing Education programs. Under existing policy, each of the three tuition structures is separate with its own unique rate setting process. The Academic Year and Summer Session tuition and fees are set by the Board of Higher Education and Continuing Education rates are set by the institutions.

The tuition and fee rates shown in this publication represent the enrollment charges assessed to students in the Summer Session programs of all institutions. These charges are comprised of the following separately maintained fees: Tuition, Mandatory Enrollment, Universal Resource Programmatic Resource and One-time fees. The revenue generated by each fee element is dedicated to a specific purpose, independent of the other components. Students enrolled under the Part-time Student Fee Policy are subject to assessment of fees appropriate to specific courses taken. Institutions have the option of assessing resource and other fees during the Summer Session at rates comparable to those assessed in the preceding *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*.

The proposed fee rates and policies for the 2010 Summer Session are set forth in the accompanying tuition and fee schedules beginning on page 15. The housing section included in this document reflects contract policies and rates for summer dormitory housing starting on page 40.

Tuition

Tuition supports the direct instruction and administrative costs of each institution's Summer Session program. To determine the recommended tuition rates, institutions must balance the fiscal requirements of their Summer Session programs with market considerations, including tuition rates of competing education providers. Institutions are not required to make a residency determination for summer term but may choose to do so.

Mandatory Enrollment Fees

Building Fee: The Building Fee is assessed at the same rate for all institutions. Historically, the Building Fee charge for Summer Session is approximately 75% percent of the academic year rate. For summer 2010, the rate will be \$34 per student. Oregon Revised Statute 351.170 allows OUS to assess up to \$45 per student per term to finance debt service for construction associated with student centers, health centers, and recreational facilities constructed through the issuance of Article XI-F(1) bonds.

Incidental Fee: Recommendations for the Incidental Fee are generally made by student committees in accordance with a Board-approved Incidental Fee Policy (OAR 580-010-0090) on each campus. In some instances, the student committee recommendations are supported by campus student referenda. The funds generated by this fee are to be used for "student union activities, educational, cultural, student government activities, and athletic activities." The president of each institution reviews the student committee recommendations then submits the recommendations to the Chancellor for final review and approval by the Board of Higher Education.

Health Services Fee: This fee is used to support each institution's student health services, which are operated as an auxiliary enterprise on a self-sustaining basis. Optional health insurance policies are covered by this fee and made available by some institutions. During Summer Session, student health services may function at reduced levels or are not provided at all. The recommended Summer Session rates reflect these lower levels of activity.

Recreation Center Fee: This fee is used to fund the construction and operation of Student Recreation Centers. It is assessed to provide additional funding as the Building Fee is not adequate to fully fund or operate projects of this scale. PSU added this fee in 2009-10 to support the operations and pay the debt service on its new Academic Student Recreation Center (ASRC). Other OUS campuses are also currently contemplating fees of this type.

Universal Resource Fees

Registration Fee: The Registration Fee is used to defray the costs associated with registration activities, awarding and disbursement of financial aid, enrollment and fee payment processes, grade processing, and degree certification.

Technology Fee: The Technology Fee is currently used for the support and improvement of student-related computing facilities and services, including network infrastructure. The fee makes possible the creation and expansion of information technology services within the library, general classroom, and departmental areas. A student advisory committee participates in setting this fee rate each year and gives input regarding the scope of services to be funded with this fee revenue.

Programmatic Resource Fees

Programmatic Resource Fees were established to provide funds to assist with faculty, resource materials, equipment and specialized services. Programmatic Resource Fees vary by institution and are assessed to students admitted to, or enrolled in a school, college or department, or degree program.

One-time Fees

The Matriculation (all campuses) and Transcript for Life (OIT only) Fees are examples of one-time fee charges to new or transfer students. This fee is a one-time assessment and was developed to reduce the large number of enrollment-related fees for student orientation, course schedules (drop/add fees), transcripts, degree applications, and re-enrollment. The fee is also used to support academic programming for Freshmen Interest Groups and Learning.

Fee Policy

The State Board of Higher Education at its January 8, 2010 meeting adopted the *2010 Summer Session Fee Book* as a permanent rule through Oregon Administrative Rule 580-040-0035. Fee policies outlined herein apply to the 2010 Summer Session. Fees and policies that are not specifically described for the summer but are applicable throughout the fiscal year (July 1 through June 30) are administered under the preceding *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*.

1. Tuition rates may be assessed based on undergraduate and graduate course designation or student classification.
2. Course level designations are generally defined as follows:
 - a. Course numbers assigned 499 and below are assigned undergraduate fee rates.
 - b. Course numbers assigned 500 and higher are assigned graduate fee rates.
3. Semester rates for students attending the University of Oregon Law programs are modified for the Summer Session program.
4. Tuition may be assessed on a per-credit hour basis or aligned to the preceding academic year structure.
5. Staff, qualifying family/dependents, and graduate assistant fee privileges may be authorized during the Summer Session at the option of the institution. If authorized, fees and study privileges shall conform to policies set forth in the preceding, *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*. Staff members or qualifying family/dependents who seek to use the staff fee privilege for courses away from their home institution are subject to corresponding fee policies of the instructing institution.
6. Cooperating supervisors of OUS Student Educator Professionals will be allowed to exercise contract provisions in accordance with policies set forth in the preceding *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*. The program title has changed to the University/School Partnership Co-Pay Program.
7. The Concurrent Enrollment Fee Policy was eliminated effective January 1, 2004.
8. Resource fees may be assessed during Summer Session under the policies set forth in the preceding *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*.
9. The Building Fee is assessed at \$34.00 per student as a mandatory charge to all students attending Summer Session classes, on-campus.
10. The Incidental Fee is based on recommendations and incidental fee guidelines of each institution. Summer fee rates cannot exceed the per-term amount charged during the previous academic year. Institutions may choose to extend incidental fee services to students not enrolled for Summer Session, under the following conditions:
 - a. A student had been enrolled in the prior academic year term and is expected to enroll in the subsequent academic year term; and
 - b. The student pays the Summer Session Incidental Fee.
11. The Health Service Fee is authorized by the Board based on institutional recommendations for the level of service to be provided during the summer. Summer fee rates cannot exceed the per term amount charged during the previous, *2009-10 Academic Year Fee Book*. Institutions may choose to extend health services to students not enrolled for Summer Session, under the

following conditions:

- a. A student had been enrolled in the prior academic year term and is expected to enroll in the subsequent academic year term; and
 - b. The student pays the Summer Session Health Services Fee.
12. Off-campus tuition rates may be established by each institution for summer courses taught outside the campus boundaries. Building, Incidental, and Health Services fees are generally excluded from off-campus tuition rates but may be assessed when the course enrollment includes the opportunity for participation in services provided by such fees.

Special on-campus tuition rates may be established by the institution for specific short-term, on-campus instructional activities including workshops, seminars, conferences, and short courses. These activities require payment of the Building Fee. The Incidental and Health Service fees are assessed only if students may participate in the services provided by such fees.

13. A student enrolled in a combination of credit and audit courses will be assessed for the total hours under the tuition and fee schedule appropriate to that individual's course or student level. If enrolled for audit courses only, the student will pay the same required fees as assessed for similar hours of for-credit classes.
14. The summer refund policy for course load reduction or withdrawal may follow the rule adopted in the preceding academic year fee book or a rule adopted by the institution. The intent of this option is to provide an opportunity for institutions to apply policies better suited to management of summer programs.

Resource Fees Transition to Tuition

In January 2008, the State Board of Higher Education approved policy changes to transition resource fees into tuition no later than Fall term 2011. Starting in academic year 2008-09, Portland State University and Southern Oregon University transitioned all universal and programmatic resource fees into tuition for both undergraduate and graduate students. Eastern Oregon University, Western Oregon University and the University of Oregon transitioned undergraduate resource fees into tuition in 2008-09.

In 2009-10, the University of Oregon transitioned graduate universal resource fees into tuition and Oregon State University transitioned undergraduate universal and programmatic resource fees into tuition and implementing differential tuition on Business, Engineering and Honors College program majors. Oregon Institute of Technology did not transition any fees into tuition in academic year 2009-10.

Summary of 2010 Summer Session Undergraduate Tuition, Mandatory Enrollment and Universal Resource Fees
