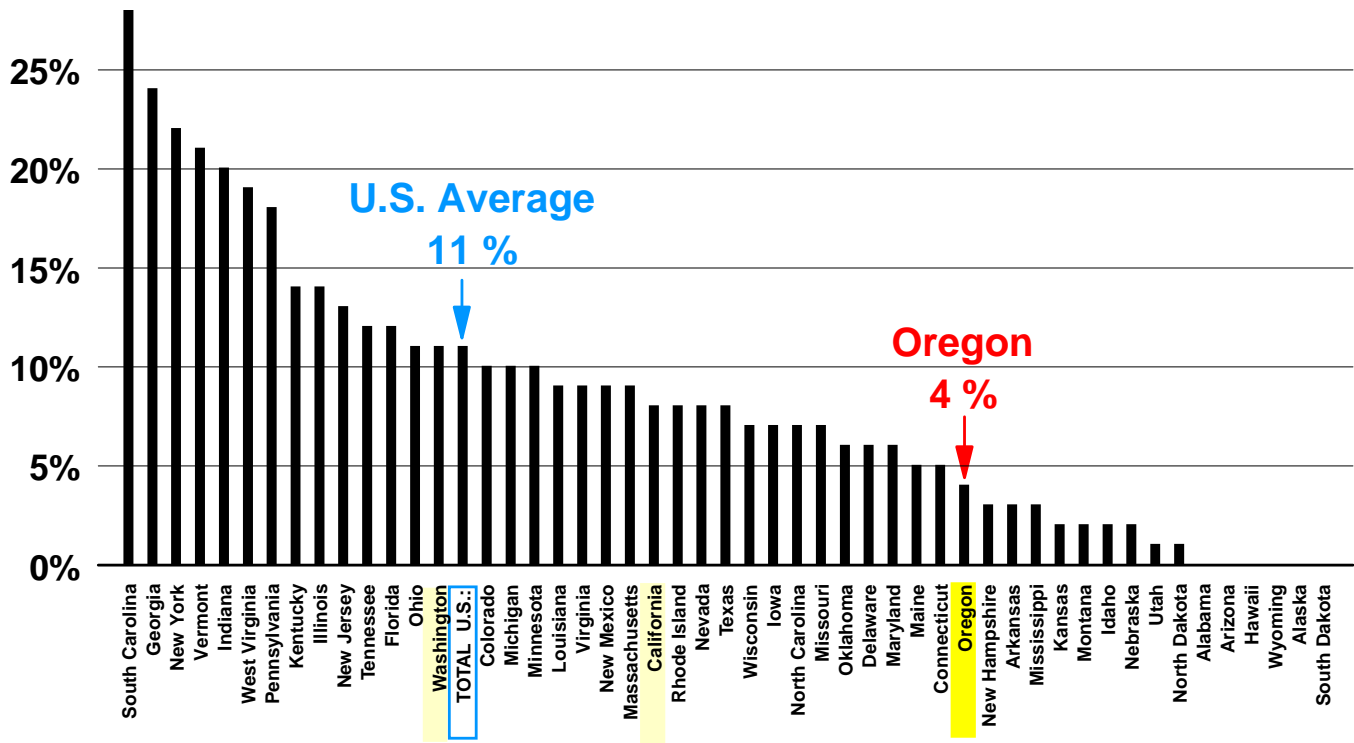

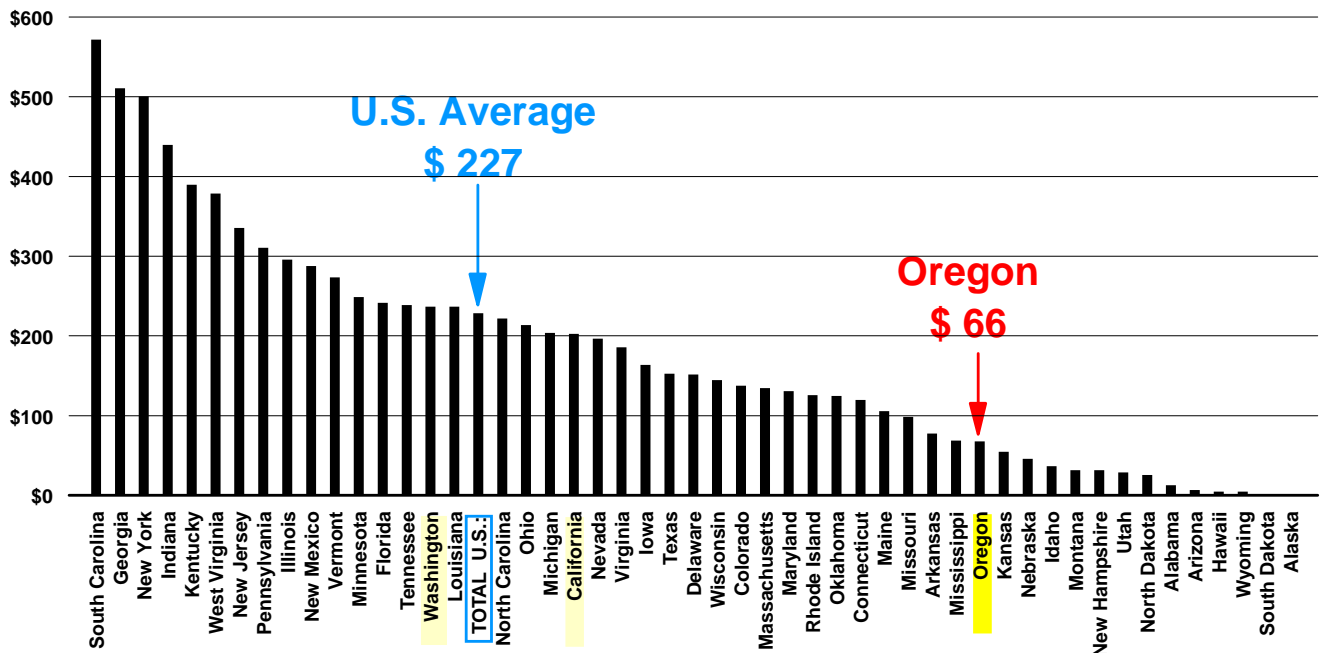

As Percentage Of State Higher Ed. Appropriation

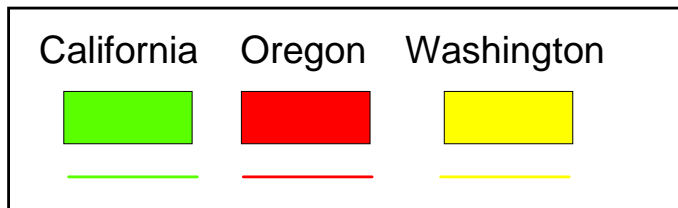
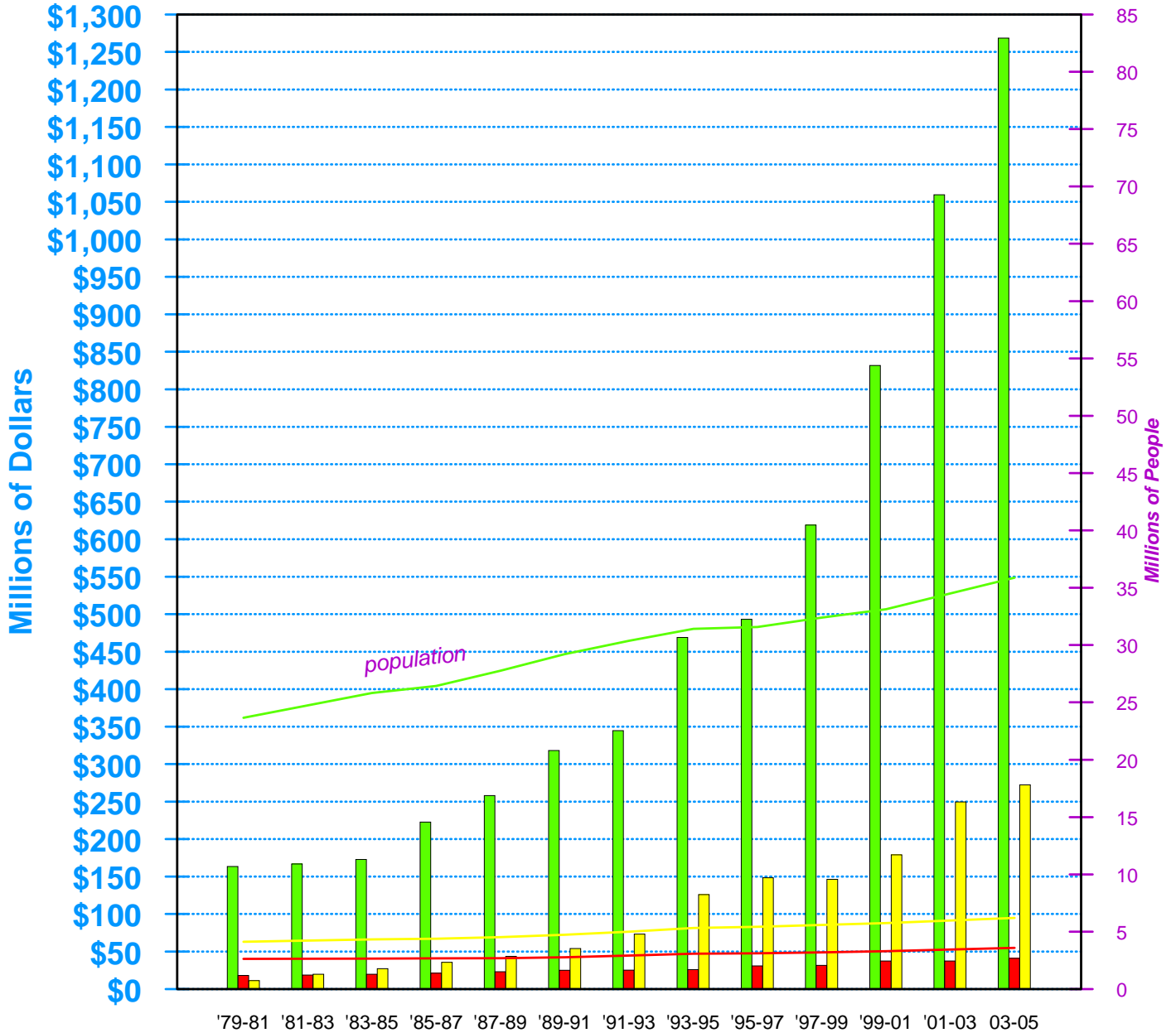


Per Resident College-Age Population
